- Mitigation area boundary**

- Improved management/infilling of existing hedges.**
Provides flight lines and foraging habitat for bats, and foraging, nesting habitat for birds such as Linnets, Bullfinches and Yellowhammer

- Existing woodland.**
Potential bat roosting habitat in existing trees and new bat boxes.

- Footpath**

- Open rough grassland.**
Provides foraging habitat for Hares, Skylarks and Starlings, also for Grey Partridge where sward is thinner.

- Tussocky grass.**
Alongside retained hedges for ground nesting birds, including Grey Partridge, and for reptiles.

- Areas where woodland/scrub will be encouraged.**
Provides foraging habitat for bats and birds such as Song Thrush.
