Dear Victoria

I am sorry that we didn't send you a full response to this correspondence.

I can confirm that the principles set out in my letter to Lucy Biddle on 10 September 2002 are still valid, although the calculations have changed a bit.

In respect of land requirements, these are now a site of 2.8 ha for the primary school (transferred to the County Council) plus 0.25 ha for a nursery / childcare facility (this could be leased by the developer to a private nursery provider). The financial contributions are set out in our current policy document (see below). If you can let me know the likely number of one bedroom units (as those are excluded from our definition of "eligible dwellings"), I could let you have an initial assessment of the financial contributions we will be seeking.

I am writing to you on behalf of CALA Homes, in respect of the proposed Major Development Area for North Winchester, as identified in the Winchester City Local Plan and Core Strategy. The site is identified to provide at least 2000 dwellings and we are currently seeking to establish the extent to which this will give rise to a requirement for new education facilities.

I have found a copy of the School Places Plan 2008 on the internet, which I assume to be


the most up-to-date information in this respect.
