Specifications are first class throughout, as you would expect from Cala, and attractive exteriors are complemented by plentiful green and open spaces for relaxation and play.




Surrounded by open green spaces




St Neots: a historic market town

There's a new and superbly landscaped business park at Wintringham too, bringing new jobs and prosperity to this much loved township.








Enjoying life to the full

St Neots is superbly located for days out... whether it's a trip down the road to Cambridge, with its history, museums and galleries, an expedition to London by train for a show or sports, or shopping and entertainment at Bedford and Milton Keynes.

Closer to home, the Riverside Miniature Railway, Southlake Aqua Park and Paxton Pits Nature Reserve are popular family favourites.

Places to go



Eating out – the River Mill Marina, in a superb riverside location, is one of many good restaurants and pubs in St Neots, and the Bohemia café and Poppy's Vintage Tea Room attract rave reviews.



Sports and leisure – there are lots of outdoor pursuits to enjoy, from golf, horse riding, cricket and football to rowing and angling or adventurous and fun water sports at Wyboston Lakes.








Parks and nature – Paxton Pits Nature Reserve is home to an amazing mosaic of wildlife habitats and has an excellent visitor centre, and there are wonderful walking routes along the Great Ouse.













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Entertainment & culture – St Neots is home to the Rowley Arts Centre with its six screen cinema and there are several theatre groups in the town, along with a lively nightlife.

Shopping – you'll find convenient local shops within walking distance at Love's Farm, and a wide selection of supermarkets and independent shops in the town.

Family days out – watersports at Wyboston and Grafham Water, wildlife at ZSL Whipsnade Zoo, laser tag at Rumble Live Action, the RSPB's Lodge at Sandy... there's a huge range of fun for all.

By foot: Wintringham Primary Academy is just 100 yards away, St Neots station is within half a mile, and it's just a little further into the town centre.




By bus: There's a bus stop on your doorstep for local services and connections to Cambridge and Bedford.




By car: The A428 is moments away, connecting to Cambridge, and it's just a couple of miles to the A1 for destinations north and south, and connections to the M1.




